- 2. **Principal's Report** (Ms. Raciunas)
 - Academic updates
 - i. NYC Reads The Science of Reading

This is new for this year. No more letter levels. Now working on decodable books.

- District is doing checks on each school on how it's being implemented. District visited last week
 - 1. Assessments this week and next via iReady and Acadience.
 - During assessment weeks- the usual lessons will not be available on iReady but will resume once children have finished assessments.
 - 3. 5th graders will be taking their State tests on computers this year. It will be the first time this has happened. Big undertaking as we need to make sure all computers are up and running and kids are familiar with the program.
- NYC State Tests results from last year are out for 3-5th graders who took the State tests. Results can be found on your NYCSA account. Log in <u>HERE</u>. Both Math and ELA scores improved greatly this year.
- Mr. Shulman worked on a grant with the Greening committee and we received a \$5K grant for the garden.
- o Academic screeners are a big push by District 14
 - iReady mid year diagnostics have been completed in most classes. You
 can see your child's results by logging in or asking your teachers for the
 Family Report.
 - ii. 3-5th Grade- Galileo Benchmarks are currently happening.
 - iii. I- Ready ELA & Math we have bought the lessons for iReady. Now that the screeners have taken place it is recommended to practice 45 mins each week. Research shows that doing lessons on iReady especially those selected by teachers, have increased students' results greatly. You can log into your child's iReady via Teachhub with your child's DOE email and PW. iReady is also available as an App for your iPad. Your teacher can provide the specific log or you can still log in via Teachhub and it will open up the APP.
 - iv. STATE TESTS:
 - 1. ELA April 11-12, 2024
 - 2. Math May 7 8, 2024
 - 3. 5th Grade Science, Math and ELA tests will be taken online this year.
 - 4. 3rd & 4th will still be paper tests.

5. LICE Protocols-

- DOE is not required to check children.
- The nurse will only check if a child is sent there directly by the teacher.
- If your child has lice please send a message to Ms. Chalkley via ParentSquare ASAP.
- DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL WITH LIVE LICE!
- Lice shampoo should be used every few days for 2 weeks until you no longer comb out NITS or live lice. Check every family member's head!
- Wear hair up for 2 weeks
- Recommended to check your kids weekly and spray their hair, backpacks, lunch bags, and coats with <u>Fairytales lice spray</u>.
- Remind them not to pile coats on top of one another!

Get the Lice Out of Your Home

- Clean all bedding, towels and clothing from the infected individual with soap and hot water (140 degrees F). Place them in a dryer for at least 20 minutes to help kill any remaining lice.
- o Dry-clean all clothes that need to be dry-cleaned.
- Seal the infested individual's stuffed toys, and other infested items that can't be laundered, in a plastic bag. Leave them for 10 days to allow all lice to die of starvation.
- Get rid of, or soak combs and hairbrushes in rubbing alcohol or the medicated shampoo used to kill lice.
- o Throw out any hair accessories, such as hair elastics and ribbons.
- Thoroughly vacuum carpets and upholstered furniture.
- Pets cannot become infested with head and body lice, so no precaution is required.
